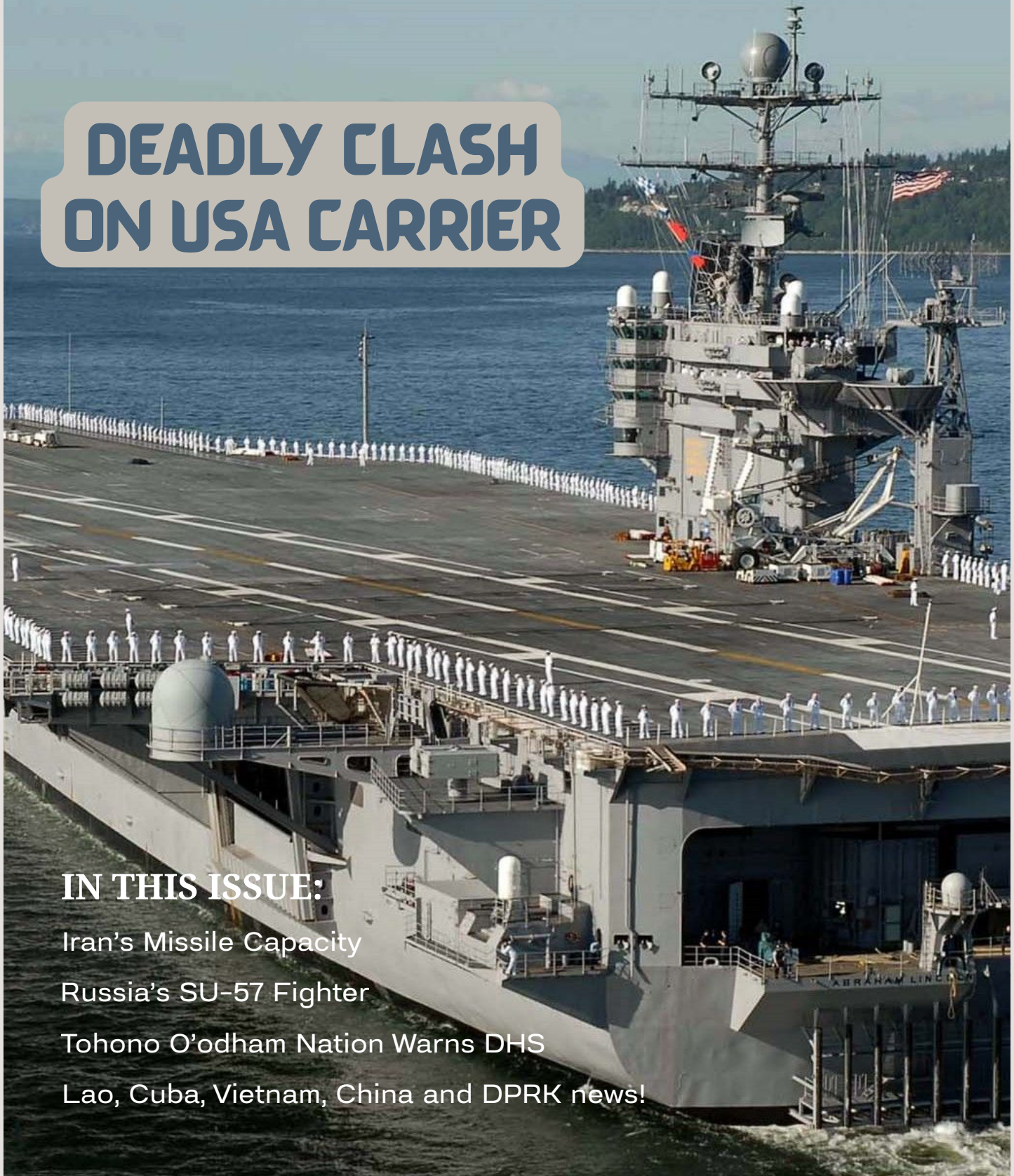

IRAN'S BALLISTIC MISSILE, DRONE PRODUCTION LEVELS EXCEED DEPLOYMENT RATE



A senior advisor to the chief commander of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) says Iran's production of ballistic missiles and drones exceeds the rate at which the Islamic Republic deploys the hardware.

The official, a former commander of the Islamic Republic's Basij volunteer forces, added that Iran would be able to maintain its retaliatory ballistic missile strikes even during prolonged engagement. - [PressTV](#)

SAUDI NATIONALS KILLED, INJURED AS YEMEN STRIKES

Yemen's Armed Forces have carried out a large-scale missile and drone operation targeting the positions, gathering points, and weapons depots of Saudi-backed mercenaries in the Mokha area of Ta'izz Province and at the Tadawin camp in Ma'rib Province.

Spokesperson Brigadier General Yahya Saree announced the information in a statement on Tuesday, saying the operation involved a large number of ballistic missiles and attack drones, which struck designated targets, including command centers.

Saree added that the strikes killed and wounded dozens, including Saudi nationals. - [PressTV](#)



DEADLY CLASH ABOARD US CARRIER ABRAHAM LINCOLN

Seven US Navy personnel have reportedly been killed and several others wounded in a violent clash aboard the USS Abraham Lincoln, as growing unrest among the carrier's crew has exposed mounting pressure inside the US military amid a prolonged deployment.

The incident erupted after an adviser to US Central Command (CENTCOM) chief Brad Cooper boarded the carrier to address mounting complaints from crew members following protests by their families over the ship's prolonged deployment, according to Tasnim News Agency, citing an informed military source.

The adviser was reportedly met with boos and had water bottles thrown at him while addressing a gathering of personnel.

The confrontation subsequently escalated into a fight among crew members involving knives and other bladed weapons, leaving seven personnel dead and several others wounded, according to the source.

The atmosphere aboard the carrier remains tense and unsettled, Tasnim reported.

The Abraham Lincoln has been deployed for 263 days and is currently operating in the Indian Ocean, where its primary mission is to enforce an illegal naval blockade against Iran.

The carrier has spent 208 consecutive days at sea, the longest continuous deployment of any US aircraft carrier in the modern era, apart from a brief stop in Oman in July. - [PressTV](#)



SU-57 CONSTITUTES KEY ELEMENT FOR ACHIEVING AIR SUPERIORITY

The fifth-generation Su-57 fighters today have no analogues in the world, and are a key element for the Russian Air Force to achieve air superiority, Air Force Commander and Deputy Commander-in-Chief of the Russian Aerospace Forces Sergey Kobylash has stated.

Speaking about the Air Force fleet, Kobylash noted that the tasks of aviation support for troop operations are carried out by multirole 4++ generation fighters Su-35S and Su-30SM, as well as Su-34M bombers. He added that strategic deterrence, as well as strikes against critical enemy targets deep in its territory, are ensured by long-range aviation forces, armed with Tu-160, Tu-95MS and Tu-22M3 missile carriers and bombers, equipped with both special and conventional long-range precision weapons.

He added that during the special military operation, Russian aviation and aviation munitions "have reached a qualitatively new level, making it possible to effectively engage aerial targets, including cruise missiles and unmanned aerial vehicles, and to deliver strikes with precision weapons both on the front line, in the tactical zone, and deep in enemy territory, which previously was accessible for fire engagement only to cruise missiles employed by long-range aviation and the navy." - [TASS](#)

UKRAINIAN FORCES CHOOSE TARGETS TO SOW FEAR

The Ukrainian armed forces are seeking to spread panic and fear among Russians by selecting appropriate targets for their strikes, Hero of Russia Yevgeny Poddubny, leader on the United Russia party's election list, war reporter and deputy director general of the VGTRK broadcaster, said in an interview with TASS Director General Andrey Kondrashov, aired on the Vesti news program. At the same time, Poddubny added, the Russian army is targeting military and energy facilities of the Ukrainian armed forces that are involved in the conflict. "In this sense, I am very glad that my country has a huge moral advantage in this struggle. We do not aim to sow fear in Ukrainian society at any cost. We fight fairly. We strike at military targets. And these strikes have very clear objectives. We need to destroy the enemy's armed forces. This is a clear and direct objective," he noted.

The military correspondent emphasized that the most important thing for Russia right now is to prevail, because, despite the fact that most of the country does not feel the brunt of the hostilities, the enemy has set a goal of destroying Russia. - [TASS](#)

GERMAN LAWMAKER CALLS ON GOVERNMENT TO REIN IN FINANCIAL AID TO UKRAINE

A German lawmaker has called on the country's government to stop allocating lavish funds to Kiev and set limits on support for Ukraine.

He recalled that since February 2022, Germany has allocated more than 100 billion euro in assistance to Ukraine. "Added to this is Germany's share in the EU aid, which currently stands at 216 billion euros. Now, they are mobilizing 90 billion euros more at European level, whilst the first EU states - the Czech Republic, Hungary and Slovakia - are seeking to shy away from providing funding," he noted. - [TASS](#)

BORDER WALL CONTRACTORS WARNED NOT TO TRESPASS ON THE NATION
"No Trespassing" Signs Going Up as Contractors May Attempt to Enter Tribal Lands

SELLS, Ariz. – The Tohono O'odham Nation's leadership has been informed that federal contractors, hired to construct a border wall and related activities, may attempt to illegally enter the Nation's lands.

If the contractors enter our lands for this purpose, without prior authorization from the Nation, they would be illegally trespassing. As a result, no trespassing signs are being posted in various locations across the Nation.

To be clear, all Tohono O'odham Nation members are free to travel as usual.

The restrictions are only for non-tribal members who are associated with border wall construction that would take our land, destroy our sacred sites, and separate our people.

THE LEGACY OF FIDEL CASTRO



August 13 marks the centennial birthday commemoration of Fidel Alejandro Castro Ruz, affectionately known as "Fidel" to hundreds of millions of people around the globe. Fidel was the leader of the 26th of July Movement that eventually defeated the U.S.-backed puppet regime of President Fulgencio Batista in Cuba on Jan. 1, 1959.

It was in early 1961, at the time of a revolutionary victory over a CIA-sponsored invasion at the Bay of Pigs (Playa Girón), that Fidel declared that a "socialist revolution" was made under the noses of the U.S. By the end of the same year, he stated that he was a Marxist-Leninist.

For the next 52 years, from the triumph of the Revolution until his formal resignation in 2008, Fidel was the leader of the Cuban people. He died at the age of 90 on Nov. 25, 2016.

Fidel's exemplary revolutionary guidance helped Cuba to navigate through difficult times, including the U.S.-led Bay of Pigs invasion, the Cuban Missile Crisis, the collapse of the Soviet Union and loss of Cuba's main trading partners, and, of course, the ongoing devastating U.S. blockade.

As Fidel repeated time and time again: "¡Venceremos! (We will win!)" - [WWP](#)

CHINA LAUNCHES LEVEL-IV GEOLOGICAL DISASTER RESPONSE IN BEIJING

China's Ministry of Natural Resources on Tuesday activated a Level-IV emergency response for geological disaster prevention in Beijing, as heavy rainfall is forecast to hit parts of the capital over the next three days.

According to meteorological forecasts and an assessment by the ministry's Geological Disaster Technical Guidance Center, the remnants of Typhoon Dolphin, the year's 13th typhoon, are expected to bring heavy rainfall to parts of Beijing.

Parts of southwestern and northeastern Beijing face a relatively high risk of geological disasters, according to the assessment.

Most parts of the city are expected to receive more than 100 millimeters of rain within six hours and over 150 millimeters within 24 hours from Tuesday evening through Thursday, according to the Beijing meteorological service.

Beijing issued an orange alert for rainstorms at 10 a.m. Monday, while several districts, including Fangshan, Daxing and Tongzhou, issued the highest-level red alerts.

The ministry activated the emergency response at 3 p.m. Tuesday and urged Beijing's natural resources authorities to strengthen risk awareness and preparedness



and make every effort to prevent and respond to geological disasters triggered by heavy rainfall.

The authorities were asked to promptly organize inspections and risk checks, strengthen monitoring and early warning, consultation and assessment, disaster and emergency response, duty arrangements and information reporting.

Beijing's drainage authorities have put 252 flood-control teams on standby. Preparations, including the installation of flood barriers, have also been stepped up at 368 subway stations, 33 hospital campuses and 17 elderly care facilities.

In Fangshan, where exceptionally heavy rain is forecast, authorities have begun evacuating residents from high-risk areas ahead of the downpours and deployed emergency rescue teams and supplies, with more than 150,000 items of emergency equipment and materials on standby. - [CGTN](#)
